


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

The office of the Trust may be shifted to any other places as may be decided upon in this regard by the Trustees.

## 1. OBJECTS:

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#### 2. TRUST BOARD:

For carrying on the above activities there shall be a TRUST BOARD approved by the Managing Committee of the Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Pune and the said Managing Committee, Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Pune has desired and appointed the following Nine Trustees:

- 1. Krishna Kumari
- Nirmala Jotwani
- Ravi Melwani
- 4. Sanjay S. Wadhwa
- Sandeep Wadhwa
- 6. Renu Wadhwa
- Kanchan Narang
- 8. Jharna Sadarangani
- Sapna Melwani

The managing committee of the Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Pune shall also have the power to appoint additional trustees but the total number of trustees shall not exceed FIFTEEN. In case of any vacancy amongst the TRUSTEES occasioned by death, resignation, incapacity or incapability of any TRUSTEE or otherwise, the vacancy shall be filled by the Managing Committee of Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Pune.

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#### 3. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

a) The Executive Committee of the Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Bangalore, comprise of minimum 7 (seven) and minimum 15 (fifteen Trust Executive Committee members of Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Bangalore shall be appointed by the Managing Committee, Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Pune. The Chair person, Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Pune (or her nominee) and three other Life Trustees of Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Pune will be the Trustees and members of the Executive Committee of Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Bangalore. All the trustees referred to in Clause 2 have been appointed by the Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Pune as the first Executive Committee of the Trust.

- b) The Managing Committee of the Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Pune shall be competent to dissolve the EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, and shall also be competent to suspend any member of the EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OR TO REMOVE ANY member of the EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE without assigning any reason.
- c) The EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE will function for a period of three years, but the Managing Committee of the Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Pune may if they so desire extend the tenure of the EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE for a period of one year at a time.
- d) The Managing Committee of the Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Pune will have the power to appoint additional members of the EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE even during the tenure of its office.
- e) Vacancies created by resignation of members or otherwise will be filled by the Managing Committee of the Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Pune.

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# 4. FUNCTIONS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE,

The functions of the EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE shall be as follows:

To put into effect the Resolutions passed by the TRUST COARD and any directive issued by the Managing Committee of the Said Vaswani Mission, Pune.

- To frame Rules and Regulations for obtaining and extending any sort ii) of help or facilities for the Educational Institutions and Charitable Activities set up or undertaken by the TRUST.
- To undertake any work within the frame work of the aims and objects iii) of the trust.
- To delegate any of its powers for any reason whatsoever to the iv) Chairman / Vice Chairman and or Secretary / Joint Secretary and or Treasurer.
- To incur any expenditure in accordance with the budget and empower V) the Chairman to incur expenditure according to the needs in respect of items not covered by the budget.
- To allow the use of the building or buildings or any portion thereof, vi) under the control of the Trust, to any person of rorganization for a particular function (provided the function is not inconsistent with the objects of the Trust) and provided the same are not needed by the occupant institutions on those occasions.
- To appoint establishment and staff such as Manager, Accountant, vii) Clerk and etc., full time or part time as paid employees on reasonable salaries and allowances, are as Honorary employees giving them Honoraria or gifts, as and when consider desirable by the Board of Trustees

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#### 5. OFFICE-BEARERS AND THEIR TENURE:

The Executive Committee of Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Bangalore may consist of the following office-bearers:-

- a) Chairman
- b) Vice Chairman
- c) Secretary (and if need be Joint Secretary) and
- d) Treasurer

The office-bearers of the Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Bangalore will be appointed by the Managing Committee of the Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Pune from amongst the members of the EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE of the Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Bangalore.

The tenure of such office-bearers shall be three years but the Managing Committee of the Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Pune shall have the power to extend the tenure of the OFICE-BEARERS for a period of one year at a time.

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# 6. DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE OFFICE BEARERS:

## A. CHAIRMAN:

a) To preside over the meetings of the Trustee.

c) To supervise the work of the EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, the Trust Board and other Committees and, if he/she so chooses to preside at their meetings.

#### B. VICE CHAIRMAN:

To perform the duties and functions of the Chairman in the latter's absence.

#### C. SECRETARY:

- a) To call the meetings of the Trust Board, Executive Committee and other Committees or Sub-Committees and to keep minutes thereof.
- b) To execute the resolutions passed by the Trust Board, Executive Committee, the Committees and Sub-Committees.
- c) To Maintain the Register of Members of the Trust Board.
- d) To maintain the Register of Dead Stock.
- e) To incur expenditure within the budget.
- f) To make proper arrangement for paying the Salaries to the Staff engaged for the activities undertaken by the TRUST.
- g) To dispose of the correspondence carried on behalf of the Institution.
- h) To prepare the annual budget and the annual report on the working of the TRUST.

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i) To write off the Dead Stock items or dispose of old and unserviceable articles with the sanction of the Execution Committee.

j) To allow the use of the building or buildings to an inequal or organization on payment of the requisite fee for one day or more when there is no likelihood of an early meeting of the Executive Committee.

- k) To carry on correspondence with any office and to attend any court cases on behalf of the Trust.
- To develop relations with other institutions having like objects.

#### D. TREASURER:

- i. To receive in cash or kind, the donations, contributions, gifts and other funds extended to the Trust.
- ii. To maintain up to date accounts of Income and Expenditure.
- iii. To prepare annual accounts for audit and get the accounts of the Trust audited by the Chartered Accountants and for placing the same before the annual meeting of the Trust.
- iv. To open account with suitable Schedule Banks and to generate the same jointly with the Chairman and / or the secretary as decided by the Board.

#### 7. TRUST YEAR:

The Trust's year shall be Financial Year, i.e., Commencing on 1st April and ending on 31st March every year.

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8. MEETINGS:

ORDINARY MEETING:

Ordinary meeting will be called in the month of March, June, December.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING:

The meeting called in the month of March will be treated as Annual General Meeting and for budget purposes.

**EMERGENT MEETING:** 

An emergent meeting will be called by the Chairman at any time he feels such need or by the Secretary with the permission of the Chairman, if and when the need for such meeting is felt. In absence of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman such meeting may be called by the Secretary, but the Chairman of the meeting will have to be elected for carrying on the proceedings of the meeting.

SPECIAL MEETING:

Special meeting for particular purposes may be called at the written request of one half of the members of the Trust Board for the time being.

NOTICE FOR MEETING:

a) For ordinary and Annual Meetings 15 days notice shall be issued in advance.

b) For emergent meetings, only one day notice will suffice.

c) For special meetings, 7 days advance notice will be necessary.

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#### QUORUM:

One third of the total number of Trustees for the time being; but in an case not less than three shall form the quorum.

VOTES:

All business transacted by the Board shall be by a majority of votes.

#### 9. ACCOUNTS:

Amounts collected in the name of the Trust shall be deposited in any Scheduled Bank/Banks. Such accounts will be operated by the Joint signature of any two of the following functionaries:

- 1. Chairman / Vice Chairman
- 2. Secretary
- 3. Treasurer

The treasurer is empowered to keep cash with him up to amount of Rs.3,000/-.

#### 10 A. INVESTMENTS:

The funds of the Trust shall be invested in the investments specified u/s 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

#### B. AUDIT:

The Accounts shall be maintained regularly and shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant as defined in the Explanation below Sub-Section (2) of Section 288 of the Income-tax Act, 1961.

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#### 11. TENURE OF TRUSTEES:

A Trustee shall automatically cease to be such Trustee under the following circumstances:

- On acceptance of her / his resignation.
- ii. On his / her death.
- iii. On passing of a resolution by the Managing Committee of the Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Pune directing his/her removal.

## 12. MODIFICATIONS IN RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The managing committee of the Sadhu Vaswani mission, Pune may from time to time add to/amend the rules in any manner they think proper no amendment change shall be the commissioner of income-tax in this regard.

#### 13. LOANS :

No loan shall be incurred by the Sadhu Vaswani mission, Bangalore without the written permission of the managing committee of the Sadhu Vaswani mission, Pune and Sadhu Vaswani mission, Bangalore shall not lend any part of its funds.

#### 14. TRUST IRRECOVABLE:

The trust created by virtue of this deed shall be irrevocable.

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#### 15. WINDING UP:

If two-thirds of the members of the trust recommend to the managing committee of the Sadhu Vaswani mission, Pune that the trust should be wound apparent the managing committee of the Sadhu Vaswani mission, Pune accepts 19 recommendation, the trust shall be wound after discharging the debts and liabilities of the trust, if any. All the remaining property, whether movable or immovable shall vest in the Sadhu Vaswani mission, Pune which has similar objects and is enjoying exemptions y/s 11 and Section 80 G of the Income Tax Act 1961 and shall be dealt with and decided by the Managing Committee of the Sadhu Vaswani Mission, Pune.

- 16. It is declared that the Trust and the benefits of the same are open to all irrespective of caste, creed and religion. The activities of the Trust shall be conformed to the Territory of India.
- 17. It is declared that the funds and income of the center (Trust) shall be solely utilized towards the objects of the Trust only and no portion of it shall be utilized for payment to Trustees or persons as defined in Section 13(1) (c) of the Income Tax Act 1961, by way of profit, Interest, Dividend etc.
